Designed by Celia Visser of Celia Visser Design, the client requested a bathroom with pizzazz — contemporary, with a mandatory bathtub, separate shower and vanity. By altering the original narrow floor plan and moving a wall, the designer was able to introduce a central partition, separating the vanity and shower so they are easily accessible from both sides. The raked ceiling proved a challenge, but after installing the fully tiled built-in bath, any serious architectural alterations were avoided. The vanity is simple, with a bespoke, all-in-one moulded benchtop basin and colour-matched Corian plinth for storage. The tap is mounted into the floor-to-ceiling mirror, above which hangs a pendant light that provides a warm, double reflection. The tiles replicate the warmth of timber, plus an added touch of retro texture with the triangular metallic feature tiles.
